SUMMARY

Concern has been expressed for the future of the Kirkconnell Correctional Centre.

COMMENTARY

During the LBA Forum last week concern was raised at the future of the Kirkconnell Correctional Centre and it was suggested that the Centre has been under review and set for closure. Concern was also raised at the Forum that as part of a review of NSW Corrective Services that a further three jobs from the Lithgow Gaol are to be lost.

Discussions have been held with Paul Toole, Member for Bathurst, in relation to these concerns. Mr Toole has indicated that there are no correctional facilities in the Bathurst Electorate currently under threat of closure.

A number of Lithgow residents are employed at the Kirkconnell Correctional Centre and obviously the threat of such a closure would result in an adverse impact on the Lithgow economy. Formal representations should be made through Mr Toole to the Attorney General and Minister for Justice to seek confirmation that there is to be no closure of the Kirkconnell Correctional Centre and no loss of jobs from this facility or from the Lithgow Gaol.
