It was very enlightening to see Council's perspective on the 94A and the process of our development from a Council Officer's view. We at the club are both pleased and in agreement with your recommendation to be put to the Councilor's at their meeting on December 17, 2012 **"that the Club should contribute \$20,000 towards the section 94A Contribution Scheme."**

I would also like to thank your group for the open discussion with regard to the unmade lane's transfer to the Lithgow & District Workmen's Club. As you are aware there have been monumental delays caused by the State Government on the closure of the unmade lane. The unmade lane will be able to be transferred to the Club in the coming days.
