ITEM: 5 YOUTH SPACE LITHGOW LIBRARY

SUMMARY

Youth Council members viewed the new Youth Space at the Library and were briefed by Library staff on the facilities and services the Library offers to young people.

COMMENTARY

Library staff have recently upgraded a section of the Library with new furnishings and colour scheme as a dedicated youth space. Youth Council members indicated that they liked the way the space had been designed. It is hoped that this, in addition to the range of other services offered, will encourage young people to use the Library more. Council's Children's/Young Adults Library Officer gave a presentation on Library services for young people including free wifi for Library members, an after school homework centre provided by a qualified teacher and a wide range of reading and research resources. A "HSC Lock-in" program will commence in September, each Thursday night from 6.00-9.00pm providing study support and pizza to students studying for the HSC.

It was agreed that the Library promote its services for young people including a media release on the dedicated youth space, signage and promotion through local schools.

SUMMARY

Youth Council discussed ideas for encouraging young people to participate in volunteering.

COMMENTARY

A number of issues were discussed including:

- Potential opportunities for young people to volunteer, under Youth Council's auspice, during Council events such as Lithglo and Halloween. This matter to be discussed with Council's Economic Development Officer.
- That a number of local volunteer agencies with an ageing membership could benefit from the involvement of younger volunteers.
- Including an award for young volunteers in the annual Australia Day awards. This matter to be discussed at Council's Community Development Committee.
- Promotion of through the Youth Council facebook page of volunteering possibilities.
- Promoting the fact that the involvement of young people in their communities through volunteering is increasingly being considered by potential employers and in university admission requirements.

ACTION

COMMENTARY

1. Youth Week 2015

Youth Week 2015 runs from Friday 10 to Sunday 19 April. It was agreed that the Lithgow event be held on Saturday 11 April with an afternoon concert at Queen Elizabeth Park together with stalls and food. Inquires are to be made of a band called Thundermentals and local bands are to be invited to share the stage in order to provide them with exposure. Once event planning is further progressed, an invitation will be placed on Council's Facebook seeking local bands to participate.

It was further discussed that inquires be made of Blue Mountains and Bathurst Councils regarding holding a joint event in Lithgow. A draft letter to be prepared and circulated beforehand to Youth Council members.

2. PCYC Learner Driver Program

Council will follow up with PCYC the subsidizing of young people to participate in this program, possibly in the January 2015 school holidays as well as PCYC lodging a financial assistance program in October 2014 for this purpose.

5. Council to contact PCYC regarding the subsidizing of young people to participate in the PCYC Learner Driver Program including PCYC lodging a financial assistance program in October 2014 for this purpose.
